APERC - DISCOMs' request for approval for Short-Term procurement of 2000 MW of power from June 2012 - March 2013 - Approval accorded - Reg.

ORDER:

In the letter cited above, the APCPDCL on behalf of APDISCOMs, requested the Commission to approve Short Term procurement for a monthly quantum ranging from 1200 MW to 2000 MW during the period June 2012 to March 2013, in lieu of the earlier approved Medium Term Purchase of 2000 MW during June 2012 to March 2013, in view of the difficulty expressed by them to procure the quantum of 2000 MW through the Medium Term Case - I bidding route during June 2012 to March 2013, as part of the procurement through Medium Term Bidding in Case - I route for the period June 2012 to June 2016. APCPDCL has also submitted certain draft guidelines for procurement of such Short-Term power as above, for the approval of the Commission.

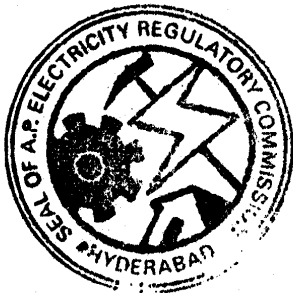
2. A market purchase requirement of the magnitude of 13,281.35 MUs by way of short-term procurement has been recognized in the Tariff Order for FY 2012-13. After careful examination of the proposal of DISCOMs, keeping in view of the difficulty of the DISCOMs to procure during June 2012 to March 2013, by the Medium Term Case - I bidding route, the earlier approved Medium Term purchase of 2000 MW, approval is hereby accorded to the DISCOMs to procure the



requirement of 13,281.35 MUs recognized in the Tariff Order of 2012-13 for market purchase, through short term purchases to the tune of monthly energy quantities mentioned in the Tariff Order (FY 2012-13), limiting to a maximum capacity of 2000 MW subject to the following conditions:

- i. Earlier approval issued by this Commission, for procurement of 2000MW of power through Medium Term Bidding, for the period between June 2012 to June 2016, is deemed to have been cancelled for the period between June 2012 to March 2013 in FY 2012-13, in lieu of the same quantum of capacity now approved to be procured through short term for FY 2012-13
 - ii. The procurement shall be limited to the monthly energy quantities and ceiling prices mentioned in the Tariff Order for FY 2012-13, with the capacity limit of 2000 MW.
 - iii. The procurement shall be in strict compliance to the conditions mentioned in the Tariff Order for FY 2012-13.
 - iv. Short Term procurement may be carried out for the requirement within this financial year (FY 2012-13) in a competitive, transparent manner, on a web based / e-procurement platform and keep the Commission informed every month, with regard to no. of transactions, price & quantity of each transaction at which power is procured, name of the seller etc without fail.
 - v. The Terms & Conditions of the above short -term procurement transactions shall comply to the Inter-State / Intra State Open Access regulations issued by the appropriate Commission, wherever applicable.
 - vi. Other Terms & conditions as may be imposed by the procurer and mutually agreed to by the sellers / procurers.
 - vii. In case purchase of power has to be made beyond the above ceiling price, the DISCOMs shall have to obtain the prior approval of the Commission.
3. This proceeding is issued in super-session of the earlier Short Term Power Procurement Guidelines issued by this Commission in the Year 2000.
