This application has come up for hearing finally on 04-08-2021 in the presence of Sri. Salman Chowdhary, counsel for the applicant and Sri P. Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the respondents, and upon hearing the arguments of the learned Counsel for both the parties, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER:

This application is filed for the following relief:

".... to pass necessary directions/orders that the generic tariff of Rs.3.43 per unit may be continued to be applicable to the Applicant's Power Purchase Agreement from the validity of the tariff expires during the pendency of the present Petition".

At the hearing, Sri Salman Chowdhary, learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that in similar cases, pending the main O.Ps., this Commission has directed the respondents to pay interim tariff @ Rs.2.43 ps. per unit from 11th year onwards and that a similar order may be passed in this application also.

Sri P. Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the respondents, submitted that subject to the adjustment of payment, if any found in excess in the order that may be passed in the main O.P., similar interim order as requested for by the learned Counsel for the petitioner may be passed.

Accordingly, the respondents are directed to pay interim tariff @ Rs.2.43 ps. per unit for the power that may be supplied by the petitioner from the 11th year onwards, subject however to the final order that may be passed in the O.P.

The application shall accordingly stand disposed of.
