APPLICATION FOR CONDONATION OF DELAY UNDER CLAUSE 59 OF APERC CONDUCT OF BUSINESS REGULATIONS IN FILING THE REIVEW PETITION OF TRANSMISSION TARIFF ORDER FOR FY 2014-15 TO FY 2018-19, DATED 9TH MAY, 2014.

The Applicant respectfully submits as under :-

- 1. Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Reform Act, 1998, and the Electricity Act 2003, the Hon'ble Commission has been vested with an important role and responsibilities towards implementation of the reform the power sector in Andhra Pradesh. Some of the key objectives of the Act are, inter-alia, to address some of the viability issues facing the sector including taking measures conducive to the development and management of electricity industry in an efficient, economic and competitive manner.
- 2. The Licensee has filed the review petition on the Transmission Tariff Order for FY 2014-15 to FY 2018-19, Dated 9th May, 2014. The time for filing of review petition i.e., 06th August, 2014 has been lapsed and need to be extended, because of the requirement of examination of the aspects viz.,
 - a. Applicability of Government Solar Policy issued in 2012 valid up to 2017, applicability of Government wind Policy issued in 2008 valid up to April 2013 and applicability of Government Policy for NCE projects including Mini-Hydel Projects issued in 1997 are examined for exemption of Transmission & wheeling charges.

- Investing of amounts on evacuation schemes of solar, wind and mini-hydel projects by APTransco are verified.
- c. Proper reimbursement mechanism from Government is needed, other wise it will be detrimental to the financial position of APTransco.
- The above said aspects could not be examined by the Licensee in time due to effect of Reorganisation Act and its consequential bifurcation of Transco into AP Transo and TS Transco.
- 4. The requisite court fee of Rs.500/- is paid herewith.
- 5. In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the applicant requests that the Hon'ble Commission may please:
 - (a) To condone the delay of 62 days in filing the Review Petition and the accompanying Review Petition may be taken on file.
 - (b) Pass such order, as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
