This Original Petition has come up for hearing finally on 05-03-2020 in the presence of Sri B. Santosh Kumar, Liaison Officer of the petitioner and Sri P. Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the utilities. After carefully considering the material available on record and after hearing the arguments of the learned counsel, the Commission passed the following:

## ORDER

This Original Petition is filed for the following relief:

"30. It is respectfully prayed that suitable orders directing the respondent to remit interest of Rs.93,59,374/- (i.e., Rs.60,10,209/- towards CSS deductions. Rs.3,26,178/-, Rs.16,76,795/- and Rs.4,46,192/- towards interest on late bill realisation for the year 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 respectively), thereby saving the petitioner company's unit. It is also prayed that the respondent be charged interest-on-interest at 14% P.A. from the date of filing onwards".

At the hearing, a letter has been placed before this Commission by Mr. B. Santosh Kumar, Liaison Officer of the petitioner wherein it is stated that a Writ Petition filed by the petitioner is coming up for hearing before the A.P. High Court today. The Liaison Officer informed that the petitioner has claimed in the said Writ Petition the same relief which is claimed in the present petition. As the petitioner has already availed a parallel remedy before the High Court, this O.P. need not be adjudicated on merits. The O.P. is accordingly dismissed, however, without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to pursue the pending Writ Petition.
