This Interlocutory Application has come up for hearing before me today, along with the main OP., in the presence of Sri P.Shiva Rao, learned standing counsel for the petitioner-APCPDCL assisted by Sri A.S.Narasimha Rao, DGM/RE/APPCC representing APDISCOMs; and Sri N.Sai Phanindra Kumar, learned Counsel for the respondent-M/s. Active Power Corporation Private Limited, through online/offline modes; that after hearing the learned counsel for both the parties, and that after carefully considering the material available on record, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

1.1. This Original Petition is filed by APCPDCL under Section 86(1) (b) read with Section 86(1)(e) of the Electricity Act, 2003, seeking approval for Power Purchase Agreement entered on 06.01.2025 between it and M/s. Active

Power Corporation Pvt Limited for procurement of Power from their 1.4 MW Mini Hydel Based power plant located on Budemeru Diversion canal in NTR

District in Andhra Pradesh.

1.2. Pending disposal of the said OP., the petitioner filed the present

Intelocutory Application to pass an interim order permitting procurement of

power from the respondent at an ad-hoc tariff of Rs.2.50 per unit or at such

rate as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Commission, subject to determination of

final tariff and approval of the PPA by this Hon'ble Commission.

2. Heard the learned counsel for both parties.

3. Sri N. Sai Phanindra Kumar, learned counsel for the Respondent, has

not raised any objection for fixation of the ad-hoc tariff of ₹2.50 per unit as

proposed by the Petitioner-APCPDCL.

4. Accordingly, the Interlocutory Application is allowed. Pending disposal of

the main OP., the Petitioner- APCPDCL is permitted to procure power from the

respondent-M/s.Active Power Corporation Private Limited at an ad-hoc tariff of

₹2.50 per unit, which shall be subject to final determination of the tariff and

approval of the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) by this Commission.
