This Original Petition has come up for hearing before me today in the presence of Sri N.Sai Phanindra Kumar, Advocate of M/s. CKR Associates, Mangalgi, A.P., learned Counsel for the Petitioner and Sri G.V.Brahmananda Rao, Counsel representing Sri P.Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the Respondents; that the learned counsel for the petitioner having filed a memo seeking permission of this Commission to withdraw the Original Petition, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

This Original Petition is filed for the following reliefs:

- a. To direct the 1st Respondent, i.e. APSPDCL, to make payment to the Petitioner for the outstanding amount of Rs.72,36,921/- (Rupees Seventy Two Lakhs, Thirty Six Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twenty One Only) payable for the period from June, 2022 to December, 2023, in terms of Articles 1.1(v), 3.2 and 4.2 of the PPA's, within 15 days of the receipt of the order of this Hon'ble Commission;
- b. to direct the 1st Respondent herein to pay an amount of Rs.33,34,562/-(Rupees Thirty Three Lakhs, Thirty Four Thousand, Five Hundred and Sixty Two only) towards interest @ 14% for the unpaid monthly invoices for the period from June, 2022 to December, 2023, in terms of Article 4.4.3 of the PPA's, within 15 days of the receipt of the order of this Hon'ble Commission;
- c. to Award costs of these proceedings against Respondent No.1 herein i.e. APSPDCL, and in favour of the Petitioner; and
- d. to Pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Commission deems fit and proper in the interest of justice.

When the matter came up for hearing, Sri N.Sai Phanindra Kumar, Advocate of M/s. CKR Associates, Mangalgiri, Andhra Pradesh, learned Counsel for the Petitioner, filed a memo seeking permission of this Commission to withdraw this Petition, *inter alia*, stating that the petitioner Company had received the dues from the respondent-DISCOMs, after reconciliation, to its satisfaction; and that, therefore, instructed him to withdraw the the present Petition.

Sri G.V. Brahmananda Rao, counsel representing Sri P. Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the Respondents, has not raised any objection.

The Original Petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.
