Public Notice

In the matter of draft Second Amendment to the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Tariff Determination from Renewable Energy Sources) Regulation, 2025 (Regulation No. 6 of 2025) and the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Green Energy Open Access, Charges and Banking) Regulation, 2024 (Regulation No. 3 of 2024)

1. The Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission notified the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Tariff Determination from Renewable Energy Sources) Regulation, 2025 (Regulation No. 6 of 2025), which was published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette on 12.09.2025. The Regulation specifies the technical and financial norms for tariff determination for renewable energy projects commissioned during the Control Period. Subsequently, the Commission notified the First Amendment to the Principal Regulation vide Regulation No. 12 of 2025 in the AP Extraordinary Gazette on 05.12.2025.
2. The Commission notified the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Green Energy Open Access, Charges and Banking) Regulation, 2024 (Regulation No. 3 of 2024), which was published in the AP Extraordinary Gazette on 02.05.2024, and subsequently notified the First Amendment thereto on 04.12.2025.
3. The Commission has examined representations from stakeholders seeking the removal of the condition requiring Renewable Hybrid Energy Projects to be connected at a single interconnection point, to provide flexibility in project configuration and optimal utilisation of renewable energy resources. Accordingly, the Commission has prepared a Draft Second Amendment to Regulation No. 6 of 2025 to permit Renewable Hybrid Energy Projects to be connected at the same or different interconnection point(s).
4. Consequent upon the above, the Commission has also prepared a Draft Second Amendment to Regulation No. 3 of 2024 to clarify metering arrangements, scheduling, energy settlement, deviation accounting, and the levy of applicable charges for Renewable Hybrid Energy Projects under the Green Energy Open Access framework.
5. The draft amendment is placed on the Commission's website (<https://www.aperc.gov.in>) for the information of all stakeholders and interested

parties.

6. Therefore, Notice is hereby given under subsection (3) of Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, read with the Electricity (Procedure for Previous Publication) Rules, 2005, informing all stakeholders and interested parties that the proposed amendments will be finalised after the expiry of **21 days** from the date of this Notice.
