Such calculations shall be filed within three days and the same shall be uploaded on the Commission's website for public information.

The petitioners filed responses to the objections filed by various Objectors. Further hearing in physical mode is held.

Sri P.Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the petitioners, has made his submissions. Sri M.Venugopala Rao and Sri M.Vijaya Gopala Reddy, learned Objectors, made their further submissions.
