As IDAM Infra has required 30% of the advance payment, they have agreed to make such a payment. Accordingly, it has been finally decided to refer the issues to IDAM infra as indicated in the order dated 10-07-2024 in the following terms. Each of the 4 parties to these petitions is ; the petitioners and APSLDC shall bear 1/4th of the fees quoted by IDAM Infra. An advance payment of 30% of the share of each party has to be made within 2 weeks in favour of IDAM Infra. A separate reference order will follow.
