Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for AP Transco & AP Discoms and Sri M. Venugopala Rao, learned objector. The learned Senior Counsel for APGPCL brought to notice that the notice in question issued by the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission relates to the undivided AP Transco and the four distribution companies of the erstwhile State of Andhra Pradesh and any adjudication of issues arising out of the said notice necessarily involves the rights and interests of TS Transco and TS Discoms as of now, apart from the AP Transco and AP Discoms. Learned Senior Counsel also brought to notice that the shareholders of APGPCL also belong to both the States of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana and hence, under the circumstances, the question of jurisdiction of the Commission to adjudicate the

issues is invariably involved in the matter, which is now under consideration of the Hon'ble High Court in a batch of matters. This statement of fact is not disputed by the other learned counsel. Sri M. Venugopala Rao, learned objector pointed out the possibility of the matter getting indefinitely delayed to the detriment of the stakeholders of the power sector due to which the question of jurisdiction need not stall the further progress in this inquiry. On the A.P. Reorganization Act, 2014 coming into force and the division of the undivided State and all its entities into two, the question of jurisdiction had arisen before this Commission, TSERC and the CERC in respect of matters arising under the Electricity Act, 2003 read with A.P. Electricity Reform Act, 1998 and the conflicting views of the three Commissions are under consideration in a batch of cases before the Hon'ble High Court. Therefore, it will be a matter of principle to follow the accepted canons of judicial propriety to await determination of the question of jurisdiction by the Hon'ble High Court. Hence, call this matter along with other jurisdiction matters on 29-09-2018.
