APTRANSCO's on the Banking and Balancing issues.

Sri P.H.Janaki Ram, CGM/P&MM, APSPDCL, while agreeing for the BBB Scheme, sought time to submit the amended PPAs. Accordingly, APSPDCL is permitted to submit their amended PPAs on or before 17-03-2025.
