Sri K. Gopal Choudary, learned Counsel for the petitioner and for the respondents in RP No. 3 of 2020 and Sri. P. Shiva Rao, learned Counsel for the respondent in O.P.No.40 of 2020 and for the petitioners in R.P.No.3 of 2020 are present at the web hearing.

After detailed hearing of the learned counsel for the both parties, the Commission is of the opinion that as what was given earlier was only principle approval for procurement of 19 MW power at a tariff of Rs.3.73 Ps per unit and the Commission has directed to take further necessary action as deemed fit in terms of approval of PPA and adoption of tariff as contemplated in the Electricity Reform Act, 1998 and Electricity Act, 2003, we are of the opinion that the issue regarding fixation of tariff and the other reliefs sought by the petitioner in this OP need to be placed in the public domain. Accordingly, the respondent is directed to carryout publication in two newspapers, one in English and the other in local language (Telugu), having

circulation in the State of Andhra Pradesh as required under Section 64 (2) (b) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and file proof of publication within two weeks from today. The notice shall give the public four weeks time to file their objections, if any. The respondent is directed to furnish all the relevant documents as referred to in the review petition to the Commission within two weeks. The Public Notice must indicate that the relevant documents are available on the Commission's website for public perusal. The office of the Commission shall place all those documents on its website.

Call on 22-06-2022 for filing of proof of publication and further hearing.
