At the hearing, Sri P.Shiva Rao, learned Standing Counsel for the respondents, candidly submitted that the dispute regarding installation of additional panels is confined only upto August, 2019; and that since September, 2019 the respondents have not been raising demand for additional panels as they have been allegedly removed.

In the light of the above stand of the respondents, the necessity for adjudication of the I.A., on merits is obviated.

As far as the liability upto August, 2019 is concerned, the same shall be adjudicated in the O.P.

With the above observations, the I.A. is disposed of.
